

The House then adjourned until tomorrow morning ten o'clock.

THURSDAY, January 15th 1835.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill, entitled an Act authorising the commissioners of Washington county, to pay certain claims therein mentioned,

Also, the bill, entitled, an Act to confirm an act to amend the constitution and form of government, as relates to the division of Somerset county, into election districts, and to establish an additional district,

Also, the bill, entitled, an Act to make public a certain road in Baltimore county,

Also, the bill, entitled, an Act for the benefit of Richard N. Snowden,

And, the resolutions in favour of William Welch, and Thomas E. Martin, were sent to the senate.

Mr. Jones of Baltimore, presented a memorial of the Visitors and Governors of the Maryland Hospital, calling the attention of the legislature to the affairs of the institution, and asking for relief,

Which was read and referred to the joint committee on the Hospital.

Mr. Teackle, presented a petition of Peter Guillet, of Somerset county, praying for an Act of incorporation, to fabricate machines, to operate by the power of gravitation,

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Teackle, Cottman, and Jones of Somerset,

And, Mr. Cushing, presented a memorial of E. J. Alcock, and W. W. Handy, of the city of Baltimore, praying the passage of a supplement to the act of 1831, chapter 205, for opening Bottle Alley, between Sharp and Hanover streets,

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Brengle, presented a memorial of sundry citizens of Frederick and Baltimore counties, praying the passage of a law, for the formation of a new county out of portions of the territory of Baltimore and Frederick counties, under the name of Carroll county,

Which was read.
