Which was read and referred to the committee on lotteries.

And, Mr. Worthington presented a memorial of sundry citizens of Prince George's county, praying an alteration of the law respecting the appointment of inspector of tobacco, and their salaries, for that county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Worthington, Pratt, Key, and Gantt.

Mr. McMahon obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, an act to suspend for a limited time, all proceedings under an act of the general assembly of Maryland, passed at December session, 1833, entitled, an act to provide for building a new court house in the town of Cumberland in Allegany county;

Ordered, That Messrs. McMahon, Devecmon, and Beall, report the same.

Mr. Duvall obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act to confirm and make valid a deed of partition, signed and acknowledged 25th June, 1821, by Henry Clagett and his wife Julia Clagett, of one part, and Grafton Duvall, and his wife, Elizabeth W. Duvall, of the other part;

Ordered, That Messrs. Duvall, Brengle and Roberts of Frederick, report the same.

Mr. Williams obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act, for the opening of Pratt Street Wharf, passed December session, 1817, chapter 71.

Ordered, that Messrs. Williams, Jones, of Baltimore, and Hughes, report the same.

The Speaker laid before the house, a report of the Treasurer of the Western Shore, in obedience to an order of the House of Delegates of the 1st. January, inst. enclosing transcripts of the last returns of the condition of the several banks in this State.

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Mr. Key, chairman of the committee on corporations, to which were referred the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Vestry of Emanuel Church, in Frederick county;

And, the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Harmony Beneficial Society, of Baltimore, reported the same without amendment;

Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.
