Mr. McLean, from the committee on internal improvements, reported a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company,

And, Mr Duckett from the committee on ways and means, reported a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Hamilton Bank,

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Duckett the house took up for consideration the bill reported by him from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, entitled, an act relating to riots,

Mr. Ely moved to strike out the enacting clause of the bill,
