

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Martin Fenwick of Anne Arundel county;

Also, the bill, entitled, an act for the building of a bridge over a stream across the road leading from Salisbury to Dereckson Cross Roads in Worcester county; severally endorsed, "will pass," ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill, entitled, an act relating to drovers driving cattle and sheep in and through Caroline county; endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment;"

Which amendment was read the first and second time by special order, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill, entitled, an act to regulate the election of clerks of the County Courts, and Registers of Wills in this State; endorsed, "will not pass;"

Also, the resolution requiring the States Topographical Engineer to make certain surveys; endorsed, "assented to," ordered to be engrossed.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Delaware and Maryland Rail Road Company, was taken up for consideration, the amendment reported from the committee of internal improvements, to said bill having been read the second time was assented to,

The said bill was then read the second time, passed with the proposed amendment, and returned to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. McLean, chairman of the committee on corporations, entitled, a supplement to an act to incorporate the Weverton Manufacturing Company;

Also, the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to erect Baltimore Town in Baltimore county into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

The hour having arrived for taking up the orders of the day, the house proceeded to consider the first order of the day being the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Real Estate Bank of Frederick county.

Mr. Sutton, moved that said bill be rejected;

Resolved in the affirmative.
