to lend some of them. We must therefore request you with  
all speed to enquire of the Gentlemen of those Provinces  
Congress, or of the Committee of Philadelphia, whether  
they will be agreeable to them, to lend us any of them and  
quaint us with their Answer; We shall want about  
forty or forty eight Rounders if we are favoured with  
any of them, they shall be returned, or paid for, if  
damaged, as there will be great Danger in attempt-  
ing to get them bound by Water, if we borrow them from  
the Officers of New-York; we judge it may be best  
to get them down by Land to Delaware-Bay, from thence  
to our carrying-Places, they may be got into our Bay  
if necessary to defray the Expence  
of them down, shall be sent you, or lodged where  
you please. We inclose you a Copy of the  
Resolution of the Convention for emitting Bills of  
Credit, which may require particular Duties to
