THIS IS THE LAST OF THE SO-CALLED "MARYLAND COLONIZATION TRACTS." THE AUTHOR APPEALS TO PARLIAMENT TO GRANT CATHOLICS FREEDOM OF RELIGION, OR TO ENACT LAWS PERMITTING THEM TO SELL THEIR PROPERTY IN ENGLAND AND EMI-GRATE TO MARYLAND. THE SECOND PART "OBJEC-TIONS ANSWERED," PROBABLY WRITTEN EARLIER BY ONE OF THE JESUITS, IS A DEFENSE OF LORD BALTIMORE'S PLANNING A CATHOLIC COLONY. IT WAS HERE PRINTED FOR THE FIRST TIME TO STRENGTHEN CALVERT'S CASE BEFORE PARLIAMENT WHERE A MEASURE WAS PENDING FOR THE REPEAL OF HIS CHARTER.
