year by virtue of fuch annuity, slipend, or other

yearly payment respectively.

And be it eracted, 'That all tobaccoes in the several warehouses at the time of affesment, thall be valued by the feveral affessors in whose hunfred such warehouses shall respectively be, and the rate of asselsment shall be notified to the several inspectors, who are hereby authorised and required to receive such atsessment before the robaccous be d livered out, except orly in case of tobaccoes purchased for the u cot this flate, the United States, or any of them, or where it shall appear by oath or affirmation of the party, or the tellimony of some indifferent winnesses, that the tame tobaccoss have been already affected in the prefent affessment; and in-case any inspector or inspectors shall deliver out such tobaccoes after notice of fuch assessment, without receiving the money que to: the assessment aforesaid, he shall be liable to pay double the value of such assesm nt, to be recovered before a fingle magistrate, who shall render account of and pay the money to recovered to the ther if of his county for the use of the public; and the said several inspectors shall, and they are hereby obliged, to pay the money by them received for the assessment on robaccoes delivered out, to the collectors of their feveral counties, within one month after they shall receive the same, under the penalty of paying twenty per cent. interest for any money by them longer detained.

And. Whereas several of the good people of this state may be able and desirous to assist their country, and support the credit thereof, by advancing sums of money, to be applied in payment of their taxes as

they arise, if properly encouraged:

Be it enacted, That if any person will pay to the treasurer of the western or eastern shore any sum of money
