At Metz the French army received a coup de grace, and has since fallen back upon Verdun in a demoralized and shattered condition. The retreat has been most disastrous. Even individual soldiers are rendered desperate by the agony of the situation, and denounce in unmeasured terms the incompetency of their Generals.
