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PUBLIC LOCAL LAW.

CHAPTER 46. AN ACT to authorize Hon. Edward Hammond, one of the Judges of the Circuit Court for Howard County, to sell or exchange a sufficient number of the duplicate copies of the Maryland Reports, belonging to the Circuit Court or Orphans' Court for Howard County, to complete the set of State Reports, belonging to the Circuit Court for the county aforesaid.

Whereas, The Circuit Court for Howard County has never been furnished with the reports of Harris and McHenry, and the seven volumes of Harris and Johnston; therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Honorable Edward Hammond, one of the associate Judges for the fifth judicial Circuit of Maryland, be, and he is hereby authorized to dispose of by sale or exchange a sufficient number of the Duplicate Reports of the decisions of the Court of Appeals of Maryland, belonging to the Circuit Court and Orphans' Court of Howard County, to make the set of Maryland Reports belonging to the said Circuit Court complete, or as nearly so as possible.

Sec. 2. And be it Enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
