THE CLIPPER TO PURSUE IN THIS ADVANCEMENT OF THE STATE

What earnest attempts are on foot by the country to make politics and the people, there are others far more wise than we conceive—who are disposed to let these matters take care of themselves in favor of creating lines of steamers to neighboring as well as more distant ports, and in reviving the trade and industry of the State, for the time paralyzed by the war.

WHILE

Realizing that we have a President already in place, for the bulk of four years, and paying him the compliment of considering him amply equal to the requirements of the office—infering that the men around him who have brought the ship of State through the perils that menaced it in storm, are competent to manage it in the calm that has succeeded, most of us are disposed to bend our attention to other matters; to conclude that to a great extent the safety of the country is secured, and that we need do what we can to repair damages, individually and collectively, to make up those losses which the State has suffered in the conflict just closed.

And without having our attention distracted by needless political excitements, there is surely enough for all to do. The whole labor system of the State—to begin with the farmers and the mechanics, and to go on to the laborers leaving found their way to the army and been deported to other States, or sought other localities of their own accord. Acknowledged to be greatly deficient in means to develop the abundant and rich resources of the State, it should be the very first business of our leading citizens to bring labor into it and to make it profitable, instead of wasting their energies in fruitless squabbling with each other as the partisans of this or that political aspirant, more intent on advancing and serving himself, than in promoting the public good. And when we remember the hardships that have come upon thousands of our people as the direct consequence of the convulsions of the times; that vast numbers who thought themselves independent in the supposed security of an institution which has collapsed under them, and find themselves with nothing but a few shreds of property, and with all but helplessness and destitution, which will expect to pay taxes and help bear the other burdens of the commonwealth, why, the question of how these people are to get their lands cultivated, those vast tracts which have thus been left on their hands, is of much more interest than whether this man shall have the Custom House, that one the Post Office, and that another a Senatorship of the United States.

And until our people realize all this, the State may suffer for an indefinite period. No one can ride through portions of it, amongst the richest sections of it, too, and not regret that so much land should be doomed to neglect and waste, whilst men, who might from their position influence a large immigration hither, are content to either remain idle, or are seen wasting their talents and energies over some petty quarrel of party, and the State wants something to draw upon for education, for railroads, for the thousand things which, combined, would set it forward in the race with its neighbors. Whilst the leading citizens of other States are doing all that is possible to re-people them, to develop their resources and to set them again on the high road to prosperity, a few, a very few public spirited men are left here to fight the battle for precedence, to encourage and bring about a better condition of things.

And now let us suppose that the case would be different. Let us suppose that men would meet with the same alacrity to obtain immigrants to occupy our waste places, that they do to witness the same bustle of political chaff thrashed for the twentieth time. By catalogue, the State Agents are to be informed—more than one hundred thousand acres of farming lands, at its disposal; the greater portion of this immense quantity comprising actual "homesteads," improved places, a vast proportion of it thrown upon the market by the actual liquidation of the owners to cultivate it; and yet the State and the General Government expect their taxes, the merchants of the city expect their commissions; and all this time the Commonwealth is to be carried to the verge of bankruptcy, and to be converted into something else.

Now, for one, until we see that tide of immigration and of capital setting in hither—which discouraging as the case looks at first, is sure ultimately to come to use a common phrase—"no one need bury their dead;" and for the rest, we are quite willing, for a good while to come, to

trust not only the new President, but his immediate counselors, with the destinies of the nation.

We want to see Maryland and her commercial metropolis "go ahead." We want to see the map of Maryland dotted all over with the names of new towns and villages; we do not wish to see the population of the entire State with all its splendid agricultural and mining advantages crowded into a single city.

Possessed of almost a Mediterranean sea and almost unequalled means for sustaining a dense population five hundred thousand, we are situated in a position which, with a field of labor spread out before the enterprising and enlightened statesman, might be the ambition of the product, can it not be that at last, we cease frittering away our energies and wasting time over petty bickerings and contentions with each other? Must the Alpha and Omega of our State Office be the Alpha and Omega of our talent and all effort? Ceasing to bandy charges of disloyalty and bigotry, ceasing to deal in whatever may prevent cordial co-operation in pushing forward the destinies of the State, is it not possible to take advantage of a promised future, another year, take steps to assure our future prosperity? "We speak as unto wise men!"
