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2 CHAIRMAN WILLIAMS: I'd like to bring to order
3 and welcome everyone here tonight. I'd like to
4 introduce Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas panel members.
5 To my immediate right is Bill Corkran. To his right is
6 Shepard Krech, and to his right, is Tom Jarvis. All
7 members of the Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas Commission.
8 Our staff representative tonight is Pat Pudelkewicz.

9 And I'd like to state the purpose of the
10 hearing, and that is to hear public comment on Talbot
11 County's request for 25-1/2 acres of growth allocation
12 for Tilghman on the Chesapeake, which would be an
13 amendment to the Talbot County Critical Areas Program.

14 The Critical Areas Commission must make a
15 decision on the county's request for growth allocation
16 by December 25, 1990. It is scheduled to come before
17 the commission on November the 7th, 1990, for a vote.
18 I'd like to recognize the court recorder that we have
19 here tonight. Seeing that there is no testimony, I
20 would say that we could go ahead and close the meeting
21 at this point.
