Teachers will have the opportunity to broaden their knowledge on the major events of the Chesapeake Campaign during the War of 1812. Learn techniques which bring primary source documents into the lesson plan, attend lectures from scholars and researchers, as well as tour War of 1812 landmarks in Annapolis.
