DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Lawrence C. Smith House is located on the south side of Old Route 40 near the intersection of Warm Springs Road, Gilpen, Allegany County.

The Lawrence Smith house is a two story, three bay wide, rectangular block. Two additions abut the house on the east and west sides. Both the additions and the main block are covered with weatherboard. The entire structure rests on a high foundation that is a combination of stone and replaced cement block. The roof is gabled with a soffit and covered with tin. Windows in the house are double hung wooden sash frames with a combination of six over six and one over one lights. The main entrance is located on the south side and features a replaced door and hardware. A hipped roof, three bay end porch supported by Roman Doric columns, covers the main entrance. A second enclosed porch is located at the rear of the building. The house has a single brick chimney^{is} located in the interior of the building.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Lawrence Smith House was built in approximately 1872. The house sits on land known as "The Tannery Tract". The tannery was owned by Jason Hanks, a prominent businessman who owned three tanneries in Chaneyville, Gilpintown & Everett. Given the location of the Smith house, it is possible that the house was built by Jason Hanks or by one of his children.
