<p>66-72 North Mechanic Street in Cumberland, Allegany County, stands on the west side of the street, beside Wills Creek, in the block formed by Frederick and Bedford Streets in the central business district.</p> <p>The building is a late nineteenth century Queen Anne-Romanesque brick structure of two and a half stories with a new commercial front at the street level, and three groups of three windows, now filled in with glass brick, on the second floor. The center group has round arches and the flanking groups have segmental arches. The top story has brick indentations flanking a closed group of three arches. The roof balustrade rises to a peak in the center.</p> <p>The building is structurally sound. The upper level of the facade is basically unaltered except for the windows.</p>

<p>66-72 North Mechanic Street is typical of the Queen Anne-Romanesque influenced commercial architecture found in late nineteenth century Cumberland. Unfortunately, the neighboring have been razed and the sites of 66-72 bricked over. The building stands alone without the environment that would have been a part of its original design.</p>


