<p>Located at 10 North Liberty Street in Cumberland, Allegany County, the building stands on the western side of the street to the north of Baltimore Street.</p> <p>The building is a 1902 brick structure, two stories high, with a shop front on the ground level, and a double-hung wooden sash window with stone framing and a three sided bay window in an arcade with a keystone. The area above the bay window in the arcade has leafy decoration and the year 1902. A high relief sculpture of a lion's head is in the area beneath the center window of the bay. The facade (east side) is cranniel with a heavy bracketed cornice with roof balustrade.</p> <p>Structurally sound, the upper stony appears to be basically unaltered from its original appearance.</p>

<b>STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE</b>  <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The date on the front of this building indicates that it was erected in 1902. The design is classical with elements of the Romanesque style seen in the arcade. It is typical of the eclectic commercial architecture of Cumberland at the beginning of the twentieth century.</p>


