DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building is located on the southeastern side of Slabtown Road in Slabtown.

The rectangular building is one and one-half stories tall and three bays wide. Wall construction is frame with board and plain batten. It rests on wooden posts with no water table. The gable flank roof is covered with tar paper. Eaves consist of a cornice and bed moulding. Two replaced cement block chimneys are located outside end.

The main entrance is located offset near the center of the northwestern facade and includes a four paneled door with original hardware. First floor windows are pegged six over six light sashes. One and one-half story windows are replaced pivoted one light. A shed roofed porch with replaced posts is on the northwest.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Slabtown Board and Batten is located on Slabtown Road in Slabtown.

This house was probably built as company housing by the Union Mining Company. According to the Index of Land Records in Allegany County the company bought the majority of their property between 1870 and 1900.(1) This house was built sometime in that period. In 1943 Robert Harden bought this house along with a large tract of land from the Union Mining Company.(2)

The rectangular building is one and one-half stories tall and three bays wide. Wall construction is frame with board and plain batten. It rests on wooden posts with no water table. The roof is gable flank.


