ca. 1800

The Stone Ruins are the remains of what is believed to have been a two story, three bay wide stone structure, laid in Rubble bond. The House was probably built circa 1800. The date is based upon the similarities in construction between this site and the Brumage and Allen Stone houses, which were constructed in the late 18th century.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Stone Ruins located on the west side of the new Route 36 at the intersection of Neff Run in Allegany County.

The building, which is now deteriorated with only the foundation ruins remaining, is believed to have consisted of a two story, three bay wide, rectangular shaped stone structure. The stone is laid in rubble bond, is up to eighteen inches thick, and supported by a continuous stone foundation. Other features of the house are unexposed and no prior records are available for description.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Stone ruins are the remains of what is believed to have been a two story stone house built circa 1800. The remains of the walls appear to be of the same construction era as the Brumage stone house, AL-VI-B-042 and the Allen stone house, AL-VI-B-034 which are in the same vicinity. The house probably served as a simple residence to an early settler; however, deed references could not be traced beyond the coal company's ownership to prove this theory.
