DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

"Linden Grove" is a three-part brick and frame house located in a grove of trees, on a hilltop south-west of Davidsonville. Little is known about the history of this house but it may have been built in the mid-18th century. The property appears on the 1860¹ and 1878² county maps as owned by M.S. Robinson and Elizabeth Robinson respectively.

The principal section of the house is one and one half stories with a gambrel roof. It has a center hall and entrances on both the east and west sides. There is a 9 over 6 pane window on either side of each door. There are also two shed dormers on either side of the roof. This section has brick end walls and brick foundations. The front and rear walls are frame, covered in horizontal lapped siding. The south end wall has two exterior chimneys with a brick pent closet between them.

The middle section of the house is a two story, one bay, frame structure with an A-roof. There is a single large chimney between this and the main section of the house.

The kitchen wing, on the north end of the building, is frame, 1 1/2 stories with an exterior brick chimney and a gambrel roof. The facade has 2 bays of 6 over 6 pane windows. There is a shed dormer on either side of the roof. A wide screened porch covers the back of the kitchen. The brick foundations of the kitchen curve in from the ground to the base of the walls. This does not appear to be structural failure.

There are two secondary buildings of interest. Near the kitchen stands a small frame shed with a 4 pane window in one end wall and the remains of a battened door on the south side wall. The framing is hand-hewn and the horizontal butt-jointed siding is unusually wide.

At some distance to the south east of the house is a large tobacco barn which appears to be quite old.
