DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Several interesting tenant houses are located at Ivy Neck Farm.

The largest, and the only one still occupied, is located at the end of Cumberstone Road. The principal part of this two-story frame structure was built in the 1880's. A smaller section in the rear is believed to have been moved from another location and to be much older.

The Front section is two stories high and three bays long. It has a center hall and stair with one room on either side. The front elevation has 2/2 pane windows. There is a raised gable, containing a window, over the center bay. A wide screened porch extends across the front.

The smaller section is one and one half storied high, has a steep A roof and a large end chimney. Its windows are smaller, with 6/6 pane sashes. The section contains a modern kitchen with a single room above, reached by an enclosed, winding stair.

The exterior of the entire house is sheathed in gray asphalt shingle.

Another structure located on the farm is known as the "Granary". 19th century maps indicate that it once also served as a tenant house. The structure is frame, one story with a A-roof. It is in poor condition but is notable for the size of its framing timbers. The sills measure approximately 14" x 14" and the columns about 10" x 10".
