DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Mushake house stands at a distance from the road. It is a 2 1/2 story, 3 bay frame building on a traditional side-ahll, double-parlor plan. and dates from about 1846. Its horizontal wood siding is original. The windows are 6-over-6 and the dormers are trimmed with square-corner moldings. The two windows on each gable and end are 2-over-2. The chimneys do not match; one of them may have been rebuilt. The kitchen wing was built in the 1950's. Several changes were made to the main house at that time. The double parlors were made into one large room and the fireplaces were closed off.

William Sheppard is listed as owner of the property, known as "Greenock Park Farm", on the 1878 county map. The same family owned the house until the 1920's.
