The Latham house was built in the 1860's by James Cheston. The floor plan is a symmetrical, having a side hall in the front wing with the stair in the rear wing. The interior details are plain and rather crudely executed. The exterior, on the other hand is decorated with ornate scrollwork barge-boards, and turned fiörimals on the steeply pitched roof. There are cathedral windows in the gable-ends and a bay window in the living room.
