

Though altered from a carriage house to a residence 116 Duke of Gloucester Street is important historically as part of Ridout's Annapolis residence. Architecturally, it is important as part of the Ridout House group, and especially because of its location on the Street, part of a row of Georgian structures tied together by a brick sidewalk. 116 has a veranda on the side away from the Ridout House and its doorway is a copy of those on 110 and 114. Windows are 6/6 with splayed lintels and shutters.


