ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL OR STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Gable on low hip, with modillioned cornice with returns; entrance pavilion projects at front facade, outline by engaged pilasters. Second floor windows with round arches, with three at entrance pavilion; entrance door with semi-circular fanlight, good double doors; side facades were seven bays, expanded with great care to eleven, all defined with engaged pilasters, with round arched windows at second floor, elliptical at first, simple corbeled cornice. Later wing at left.






St. Mary's Hall is a very fine institutional Victorian structure, used for school and for social events. The street facade has long arched windows with drip moldings and an arched entrance with semi-circular fanlight. The sides were originally 7 (now 11) recessed panels each with an arched 9/9 window on 1st storey and a Gibbsian - Venetian 12/9 window on 2nd storey. In good shape and good example of type.
