

The Ireland House was the site of St. Mary's first parochial school, in addition it is a fine example of a Federal town house, one whose growth can be followed by the subsequent additions running down Duke of Gloucester Street. Besides typical 6/6 triangular dormers, 9/6 shuttered windows, etc. there is one large chimney with 4 arched hoods. Interesting visually, the Ireland House occupies important corner location not far from Ridout House and 1st Farmer's Bank at 160 Green Street.
