



4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC  no

The Henry House is one of the most delightful little Victorian houses in Annapolis. Architecturally it is correct and has been unaltered. The house is capped by a fine bracketed cornice with floral dentils and three jig-saw frieze panels. 2nd storey has three long, narrow, shuttered 2/2 windows. Beneath a porch supported by three unevenly spaced columns are two identical windows and a period door with single light transom. One of the nicest features about 169 is its location way back from the street, giving it a nice yard. Though land is valuable in Annapolis occasional such yards and setbacks make the street-scapes visually more interesting as well as exposing the sides of various buildings. Rear part of building may be as old as 1750.




6. LOCATION MAP (Plan Optional)


