DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Tracy's Landing Tobacco Barn #1 is located in an uncultivated field approximately 100 yards northeast of Tracy's Landing Elementary School, situated at the intersection of Route 2 and Route 256, Tracy's Landing, Anne Arundel County, Maryland.

The original section of the 24'x51' barn consists of a late eighteenth-early nineteenth century three pen barns, with sills cut for a drive-through. Shed additions have been added on all three sides, which are sheathed in vertical boards. The entire roof is covered with corrugated sheet metal.

The original section of the barn is constructed with oak, chestnut and walnut posts, plates and sills, with poplar (?) studs. Original riven clapboards, held in place with wrought iron rails, are evident at the southwest corner. Later nails, including a combination cut nail with hand made head ("double stuck" nail, dating from 1790-1815), and other second generation machine nails, are present.

The most impressive construction detail is the tilted false plate eave construction, with overhanging decorative rafters. Roof rafter sets (placed at a 54° angle) are secured by three sets of collars and a small riven collar at the peak. Wrought iron nails connect the collars to three vertical members, half saplings lapped over each collar. Other construction details include cross sills at ground level with double tenons, the top tenon fitting over the top of the wall sills.

A later 20th century stripping shed is located at the southeast corner of the shed roofed addition.

The base to a tobacco prize is also located under the southwest corner of one shed addition. One half of the base is hewn out to accept the hogs heads. The prize itself is missing.

(Note: This barn was surveyed by Orlando Ridout V, Wayne Nield, and me on March 19, 1980. Orlando Ridout's field notes are appended).

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Tracy's Landing Tobacco Barn #1 is significant as one of two probable 18th century tobacco barns extant in Anne Arundel County. The original barn, now covered by three shed additions, represents a survival of a type of agricultural building which contains many 17th and 18th century construction details. These include the use of the fitted false plate and decorated overhanging rafter system, clapboard sheathing, and steep roof pitch.

The barn is in the process of being measured, disassembled, and reassembled by the National Park Service, for their National Colonial Farm operation at Accokeep, Maryland.

SWAP 2/1980

Anne Arundel County's Department of Recreation and Parks plans to construct a park on a tract of land adjacent to Tracy's Landing Elementary School at the intersection of Route 2 and Deale Road. Located on the tract of land is a barn which will have to be either demolished or removed to make room for the park facilities. Inside that barn is another barn which, it is believed, predates 1800!

Approximately two-thirds of the original 18th century barn remains. There has been severe deterioration and some replacement of sills at the northern end of the barn, although the placement of the sills on brick piers and a corrugated metal roof have undoubtedly contributed to their preservation.

The framing members on the side walls are vertical, suggesting that horizontal siding was used, and traces of what appear to be hand-hewn weather boarding in four foot lengths remain on the upper west wall and south gable end.

The principal framing members are joined with mortice and tenon joints and wood pins, and appear to be of oak, chestnut and walnut. The original roof trusses appear to be largely intact.

The Department of Recreation and Parks apparently has no intention of utilizing the structure and would have no objection to the structure's removal prior to the beginning of construction.
