Mt. Olive A.M.E. Church stands on the West side of Hicks Ave. in Parole. This Italianate brick and stucco structure was built in 1952 and replaced a frame structure that was built on this site in the 1880's. The original A.M.E. congregation in this area was called the Macedonia A.M.E. Church and it was located somewhere near the junction of West Street and Old Solomon's Island Road. The Macedonia A.M.E. congregation became the Mount Olive congregation when it moved to this site.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Mount Olive A.M.E. Congregation dates from 1870 when the Macedonia A.M.E. Church was founded at Parole. Camp Parole was abandoned by Federal troops at the termination of the Civil War and became a black community. The first A.M.E. Church built in Parole was supposedly built from the wood of the old Mt. Moriah A.M.E. Church when that church was replaced by the brick structure on Franklin Street. Macedonia A.M.E. later became Mt.Olive A.M.E. and has been located on Hicks Ave. since 1886.


