





NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC yes <p>12 Church Circle has a very definite Greek, or at least ante Civil War, feeling about it - low pitch of metal roof, chimney, handsome windows on 2nd floor (6/6) with shutters - and with Greek lintels with dentils on them. The building, may, however, be another Annapolis post Civil War building that looks stylistically earlier. The 1st floor has two offices with larger windows and the siding is modern asphalt. There is a fine bracketed cornice with modillions - Victorian. The building's three shades of blue is attractive - especially amidst so much brick.</p>
