The oldest (west) portion of this house is said to be one of three stone houses built in the vicinity by Thomas K. Hartley. There is an enormous fireplace in what is now the living room. The house has thick stone walls. There is a massive stone lintel over a door in the south wall. Additions were made to the house in the early 1800s. This is apparently the George Allen house of the 1877 atlas. It was restored and modernized prior to 1965 by the present owners, the Frank G. Geimans (dec.).
