The earliest portion of the present Greenberg house was supposedly the dwelling of Captain John Oulton, who patented the grounds upon which his fort stood. It was later the home of High Sheriff John Risteau. It was much enlarged with a stone main section in the 19th century. The property was listed in the 1876 tax ledger as Cardiff Tagart's "Old Garrison Farm."
