HOSEA KAPP RESIDENCE (SITE) - 1880 - NE corner, Malvern Avenue and Bellona, Ruxton. Built of stone, containing 22 rooms, by Hosea Kapp, general superintendent of the Northern Central Railroad. Replaced by an apartment house complex. Gate remains. A roadside marker in honor of patriot Nicholas Ruxton Moore was erected here in 1977.
