BREEZEWOOD - Claimed at 1750 - Hess Road. Original building was a single-room log cabin within the wall of present library. A house of classic simplicity has been developed with stone additions coated with stucco. The museum wing is open on stated occasions for the display of a collection of South East Asian art.
