**MOUNT PERU** - 1851 - North side of Jones Road, Bradshaw. Built by Robert Taylor, Jr., a large land owner in the area during the past century. Once a show-place and center of social activity, including jousting tournaments; the house fell into disrepair until restored by the present owner. Large, white frame house in Italianate Federal design; stone foundation. Landscaped gardens, boxwood, holly, etc. The story of the former courthouse and jail standing on these grounds is based on a misinterpretation of records. Owners: Mr. and Mrs. Harry W. Riepe, Jr. Mr. Reipe was murdered by burglar on Oct. 3, 1986.
