**LITTLECOTE** - c. 1760-65 - West side of Manor Road, 0.3 mile northwest of Glen Arm Road in Summerfield subdivision. Small building, a former slave quarters of the Ridgely-Gilmor house Summerfield. During the ownership of William Merrick in the 1920s and 30s, it was enlarged by adding wings. Basic building is stone, 1-½ stories, with walls two feet thick.

Gable roof. Full-width porches is Colonial style. House is about 50 feet long, one room deep. Three dormers on each side. Fireplace in dining room contains original kitchen crane. Owner: J. Cavendish Darrell.
