

This shingled house is another variation of the typical Lutherville cottage constructed in an 'L' shaped plan with a one story porch within the angle of the wings. The porch is supported on turned columns and has a plain balustrade. Similar to its neighbors 202 and 204 W. Seminary, except for the absence of dormers, this house has its front bay window set with heavy modillions.

Triangular two light over two light sash fill the attic gables while two over two sash are typically found at the other openings which, except for the bay window, are hung with louvered blinds.


