

**MILL HOUSE** - 1800-1850 - Northwest corner of Falls Road and Lower Beckleysville Road. A survival of the Lawson's Old Mill listed in the 1841 tax ledger and shown on the 1850 map and of the E.M. Lawson sawmill in the 1877 atlas. The 1859 additions to the transfer book charged Edw. H. (or M.) Lawson with a "Frame House" worth \$500. Bromley's 1915 atlas showed the Joseph Armacost sawmill. The mill, now extinct, had been powered by George's Run. The road was mentioned in an 1869 deed as the "road from Edward Lawson's Saw Mill to Hampstead Carroll County". Three-story frame and clapboard house with gable roof; painted white; shutters painted red; stone wall; dwelling is perched on a slope and screened by trees. Two stables. Excellent condition.
