SANFORD HERSCHFELD HOUSE - Before 1850 - (North side of) 12001 Hartley Mill Road, 0.4 mile west of Harford Road. Served as home for owners of the Hartley Mill (which burned in 1924). It served as residence of John Reese, Phineas Hartley, and Phineas Hartley, Jr. First story is stone, second of log with concrete chink filling; shed roofed dormer in attic. A redwood addition was put on by the Hershfields.

DISTRICT 11 - continued -

Mill race is visible near driveway; milling on this site dates from 1769. Does not match dimensions of 1798 when Aquila Hall owned mill. May be the Edward Reese house mentioned in 1851 deed (AWB 454:400).
