Friendship Schoolhouse as early as 1829. The first chapel was built in 1846 and the present structure had its foundation laid November 21, 1900. Named for Bishop Beverly Waugh, who conducted the dedication ceremony in 1901. This is a frame church covered with composition shingling; in Gothic Victorian style; 4-bays deep, with a central entrance spire and open belfry. Gable roof; good condition.
