POWERS HOUSE - c. 1911 - 26 Waugh Avenue. Large, two-story frame, and clapboard, cruciform, house, owner unidentified in 1915 atlas, but actually the Epworth Cottage built by the Aged People's Outing Association of Baltimore City. Used by Goodwill Industries, 1942-45. Sold to private owner in 1970. In late Victorian style, gable roof, brick foundation. Elaborate porches for summer boarders, 1st and 2nd stories. Large, tall windows; bargeboards, round window in gable. Owner: Joseph D.B. Powers.
