DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Bunting House is a distinguished contemporary house built in 1972, and designed by Mark Beck, A.I.A., of Towson, Maryland. It is two storeys in height, with flat roofs; exterior walls are sheathed in narrow vertical cypress bearing. In form, the house, with its garage and porches, is a series of rectangular solids, broken by rectangular areas of glass, many of them two storeys in height and diagonally across internal corners created by the several rectangular shapes, with sloping glass roofs; they may be compared to glass prisms.

Internally, the several spaces open to one another, both horizontally and vertically, but with view and flow partially interrupted by chimneys and screen walls.

The Bunting House is a direct descendent of the International Style, originating in Europe early in the 20th century, and celebrated by such early masters of contemporary architecture as leCorbusier.

The garage doors are painted colorfully in an abstract mural by Anthony Miletto, A.I.A.

The naturalistic landscaping is well designed, thoroughly integrated into the woodland setting, relating the house to its setting on the very edge of the woods. Some changes in grade are allowed naturally, and some are defined by retaining walls of various shapes, made of salvaged railroad ties.


