PINE GROVE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, RAYVILLE - 1892 -
NE side of Middletown Road, 0.4 mile NW of Rayville Road. Originally a United Brethren Church, the present building was put up in 1892 and is still provided with carriage sheds. in the rear. The congregation dates from 1850s when services were held in the Eagle Paper mill and in Kelly's Schoolhouse. An earlier church was built in 1854. Frame and clapboard building in Victorian Gothic style; gable roof. Central entrance tower with open belfry. Aluminum siding added. Also a cemetery.
