DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

310 Lennox Ave.

A steep cross-gable and a porch supported by turned posts distinguish this narrow two-story frame house. In plan, the house has a stair hall on the east and a parlor on the west. The gable roof of this section runs east-west, or parallel to the street. A two-story section to the southeast has one room on each floor. Its roof runs perpendicular to the main roof. To the southwest protrudes a two-story shed-roof addition. The porch from the front, or north side, wraps around the west side of the house to a dead-end at the north end of the addition. The north door in the addition is flanked by four-pane sidelights and topped by a two-pane transom. The front and rear doors of the original house also have transoms. All of the windows contain 2/2 sash. The main facade is lit by two windows to the west of the front door on the first floor, and by two widely spaced windows on the second floor. The west and cross-gables feature small square windows. The entire house is sheathed in grey asbestos shingles.
