425 Lennox

The main block of this two-story frame house is three bays wide by one bay deep. A wide crossgable faces the street from the south side of the gable roof. It is lit by a rectangular six-pane window. Three 2/2 sash windows light the second floor on the south facade. On the first floor a window is positioned to either side of the central, transomed door. The gable ends each feature with a window at each floor level, including a six-pane window in the attic. The semi-enclosed porch has a shed roof supported by light columns. A rough concrete foundation underpins the structure. A small two-story addition stands to the northeast. The rear of the addition has a shed-roofed porch. The architraves consist of simple fl at boards. The entire house is covered with white asbestos shingles.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house was constructed around 1907, by Edward Mack. This was the house that his family settled after moving from the eastern most section of E. Towson, (part of the land of which is now Black & Decker Manufacturing Co.). The Mack family has lived in this house for more than seventy years. The Mack family represents one of the oldest of the original settlers of E. Towson, dating back to the early 1870's. The Mack family was noted to have owned property extensively around 1898. Edward Mack is ninety-six years old, the second oldest man in the community.
