423 Pennsylvania Ave. (Pre-1915)

This two-story Frame house, which was built before 1915 is three bays deep by two bays wide. The west bay of the south facade accomodates a fashionable floor to ceiling window, while the front door occupies the adjacent bay. All other bays contain 2/2 windows. The gable end of the house faces the street. A shed-roofed porch crossing the facade features iron posts and balustrade. The house is covered with asphalt shingles imitating red brick. It is situated over a stone cellar whose exterior entrance appears under the first bay on the west side.
