This frame house is built in two sections. The western part is of 1 1/2 story height, three bays wide by one bay deep, while the eastern part is a full two stories high and measures two bays wide by one bay deep. The eastern section has a porch across its south facade.

This frame duplex was built in the late 19th century. A three bay wide by one bay deep section on the west is a true 1 1/2 story dwelling. The two bay wide by one bay deep section to the east is two stories tall. Both parts are covered with grey wooden siding.

The west sections east-west gable roof is lower than that of the east section. Its central door is flanked by 6/6 windows on the south facade. 6/3 windows appear in the three bays in the half story above. A central flue rises between the two western bays.

The east section has a door in the western bay of the south facade. The other three bays on this side and the two on the east end contain 6/6 windows. A semi-enclosed porch running across the south facade has a shed roof supported by thin square posts.
