<p>The WINKENWERDER HOUSE is a one storey framehouse of contemporary design, built for the current owners in 1954-55, designed by Charles Nes of the Baltimore architectural firm of Fisher, Nes and Campbell. Exterior walls are covered with vertical, gray-stained cypress. The entrance is in the north side, close to a service wing which extends north from the east end. The south front, oriented to a pastoral meadow scene, is entirely of glass; windows of the north front are high, immediately beneath the wide eaves which shelter both walls. The pitched roofs are covered with slate and two simple, massive white brick chimneys rise above them.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house, constructed in 1954-55, is occupied by the original owners, Dr. and Mrs. Walter Winkenwerder. The architects were the firm of Fisher, Nes and Campbell who are the professional descendants of Palmer and Lamdin, an important Baltimore architectural firm of the late 19th and early 20th century. Fisher, Nes and Campbell, and their associate partners, have served the American Institute of Architects locally and nationally, holding various offices, including the Presidency, at both levels.
