CASTLE CALDER - 1876 - 19112 York Road, 0.6 mile north of Parkton. Gable-roofed, two-story brick house with double side porches and full width front porch; box cornice; Federal style; built to replace the original Castle Calder that had burned. Captain James Calder had come here after the war of 1745 and acquired 7,000 acres, including the Roser Mill site and a distillery. His property descended through his daughters to such families as Parkes, Rampleys, Littles, Emacks, Harrises, and Turners. Recent generations called it just "Calder Farm". Castle Calder of 1876 is property of a descendant, Mrs. Marian Turner Clark.
