EVANS FUNERAL HOME (SITE) - c. 1850 - 8802 Harford Road. Large, two-story stone house in vernacular style, blank end wall, except for small attic windows. Back building in precast, rusticated concrete blocks. Shown as parsonage on 1850 map by Sidney and as "M. C.

Parsonage" in 1877 atlas, when a toll gate was also shown here, just north of Putty Hill Road. The construction cost in 1850 was reported as \$2,848.65. Served as dwelling for the pastor of Hiss Methodist Church to the south. Demolished on September 16-17, 1980.
