OLD OREMS SCHOOL - 1861 - NE corner of Orem and Glider Road, Stemmers Run vicinity. Frame, one-story structure with outer covering of rubber shingles; on concrete foundation; hip roof with dormers in form of small triangles. Built on a tract west of Orem Methodist Church purchased

from Samuel Wilkinson in 1861. Shown as a school in atlases of 1877 and 1915. An earlier school was shown in 1850 Sidney map, but was east of the church. School acquired by Glenn L. Martin Company in 1929, by Stansbury Manor, Inc. in 1939, and by Middle River Square Club in 1947. The club, a Masonic group, now rents the school to a Baptist congregation. The highway was called Neck Road in deeds of 1861 (GHC 36:208).
