MCCANN FARM - Before 1877 - West side of Middletown Road, 0.2 mile SE of Rayville. Apparently the A. Elder house found in 1877 atlas and the A. Hayes property shown in Bromley atlases of 1898 and 1915. Two-story frame and clapboard Victorian house, cross-gabled, tin gable roof; full width front porch, internal chimney. Wing to rear. Also a large and a small red barn. Owner: Ralph C. McGann.

RAYVILLE HALL - 1896 - 0.12 mile SE of Rayville. Shown as Rayville Band Hall in 1898 and 1918 Bromley atlases, this frame structure in functional style was built by the Rayville Improvement Association and was later sold to the Knights of Pythias, Castle Hall of Rayville No. 131. Lodge closed in 1937. Building sold to Kenneth Bull, youngest member. Large, one-story building, three bays wide in front and five deep; gable roof; green aluminum siding; good condition. Owner: Robert W. Shaffer. Rayville's band was invited to play at the inauguration of President McKinley, March 4, 1897.

OGLE HOUSE - c. 1860 - South side of Middletown Road, 0.12 mile SE of Rayville. The Alex. Elder house shown in 1877 atlas and the R.D. Davis house of 1898 and 1915 Bromley atlases. Small, two-story Victorian cross-

gabled house; gable roof; composition shingles; full width front porch; three bays wide. Stands behind a welding service shop. Owner: Dallas B. Ogle.

MICHAEL BECK HOUSE - Before 1870 - West side of Rayville Road, just west of junction with Middletown Road. In 1860s was home of Enos K. Wright, first postmaster. Sold to Ann M. Brooks' in 1868, and to George R. Hunt in 1872. The G. R. Hunt house shown in 1877 atlas. The oldest house in Rayville, log construction under present clapboard covering. A double house with two front doors and two cross-gables; gable roof; fair condition. Undergoing repairs in spring of 1978. Owner: Jerry R. Phillips.
